Subject: Tyee Transmission Line Eagle Bay Crossing Marker Ball Replacement Project

A Request for Proposals for the Agency's Tyee Transmission Line Eagle River, a/k/a Eagle Bay Crossing Marker Ball Replacement Project was advertised on February 1, 2019. Three (3) bids were received on March 1, 2019 as follows:

Electric Power Constructors, Inc.	Anchorage, Alaska	\$133,806.74					
Northern Powerline Constructors, Inc.	Anchorage, Alaska	\$201,800.47					
Alaska Line Builders, LLC	Big Lake, Alaska	\$256,441.60					

The proposals were primarily evaluated on experience with Alaska generally and Southeast Alaska in particular, warranty following installation of the marker balls, general approach to the work, capacity to respond to the work in a timely and efficient manner, competitive pricing, and completeness and quality of bid documents. Based upon the evaluation, staff recommends award of the project to Electric Power Constructors, Inc. as the low bidder. \$220,000 was authorized in the FY2019 R&R Budget for the project.
